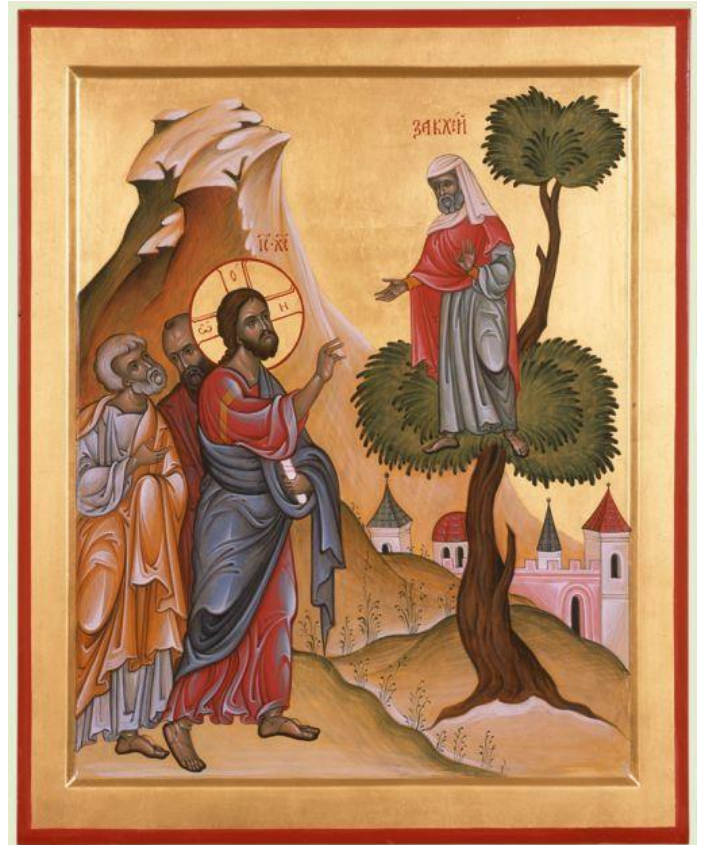

Salvatorian College is to be rebuilt as part of the State Priority School Building Programme. During re-construction a number of year groups will move to Priestmead School.
