

Sea Sunday



Next Sunday is Sea Sunday, when we are invited to remember all those who live and work at sea. Seafarers are commonly recruited from poor countries where wages are low. They work in extremely difficult and often dangerous conditions and they suffer from loneliness, spiritual deprivation and even exploitation as they transport the goods we use and consume every day.

A high proportion of seafarers are Catholics and the Church owes them and other seafarers a duty of pastoral care. The Apostleship of the Sea (AoS) is the official maritime welfare agency of the Catholic Church in Great Britain. It reaches out to seafarers that visit our ports each year, offering pastoral and practical support. The AoS is wholly dependent on voluntary donations, receiving no funding from either the Church or the government; it takes the love of Christ to seafarers in the name of the Church, recognising them as our brothers and sisters in need.

You may have noticed some changes around the College, with the erection of hoardings to enable preparatory works for the College rebuild. Over the summer Kier Construction will take over the site and begin works to demolish existing buildings to enable the first phase of the new construction. This is a significant milestone in the transformation of the College, building on a 'Good' Ofsted rating awarded in January, and having achieving the best GCSE results for boys in Harrow last year.

From September 2017, Salvatorian College is entering into a partnership with the Cardinal Hume Academies Trust, one of the most successful Catholic Academy chains in the country. The Trust is led by Executive Headteacher, Mr Martin Tissot, who will assume strategic leadership for the College from September following the departure of Mr Paul Kassapian.
