The Funeral Rites of the late Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connor will be held in Westminster Cathedral according to the following schedule:

- **Reception** of the body on Tuesday 12th September at 10am. The Cardinal will repose in the Cathedral throughout the day for those wishing to pay their respects and sign the Book of Condolence. At 5pm that evening, Cardinal Vincent will lead Solemn Vespers for the Dead and will be joined by ecumenical guests. The Cathedral will be open until 8pm.
- **Requiem Mass** and burial will take place at 12 noon on Wednesday 13th September. Please note that this is a ticket-only celebration in order to allow for the widest representation of guests from throughout the country and beyond.
- **Memorial Mass** on Wednesday 4th October, celebrated by Cardinal Vincent, to which all are welcome to attend.

On Saturday 7th October, Cardinal Vincent will lead the diocese in pilgrimage to Walsingham. As such, a coach has been arranged from St Joseph's for this occasion. The cost per person is at the subsidised rate of £10. Please see the opposite side for further information.
