Dear Parishioners,

On Wednesday 1st November we celebrate the feast of All Saints - a Holyday of Obligation. We will have three masses in church on that day: 7.30am, 10am & 7.15pm.

The senior boys of Salvatorian College will join the parish for mass at 10am, with the lower years celebrating mass on the Priestmead site in the afternoon before dismissal. Other masses are scheduled for celebration on the day at both Sacred Heart and St Teresa's schools. St Joseph's school will visit the parish for mass on the 2nd November at 10.45am.

November is also the Month of the Holy Souls when we take the opportunity to pray for those who have gone on to eternity. During the month of November special masses will be periodically scheduled for "Holy Souls" which will be offered for the names of your loved ones submitted via the brown envelopes. Names of the Holy Souls will be placed upon the Altar of Repose, which is to be situated at the front of the church between the Tabernacle and the Sanctuary during the month of November. Special 3-day votive candles will be available for purchase to light before the altar during this special time. As space will be a little tight for candles, it is asked that parishioners be mindful of this and light candles *periodically* during the month rather than all at once, thus giving everybody a chance to light at least one.

The offering of prayers for the dead is a tradition going back to Old Testament times. Indeed, Scripture tells us that "it is a good and noble thing to pray for the dead...so that their sins may be forgiven..." One of the greatest things we can do for the dead is to offer mass for their happy repose. St Brendan once said that: "the prayer of the living doth profit much the souls of the dead..." Let us, then, remember with love our beloved dead, most especially during Holy Mass.

## November The Month of the Holy Souls

Please take an envelope from the back of church and return it to the presbytery with your list of deceased relatives and friends who you wish to be remembered during the month of November. The list will be placed on the Altar of Repose and the names remembered at all November masses.

In addition, special masses for the Holy Souls will be periodically offered throughout the month too.

Whilst the clergy are happy to receive any reasonable amount, the diocesan recommendation ought to be kept in mind. Please also note that intentions written on the offering envelope should be as clear as possible. If the intention cannot be understood, it will be recorded on the list as "donor's intention".

The blessing of graves at Clamp Hill Cemetery will be going ahead this year on 12th November, beginning with a brief liturgy in the small car park near the gates at 2.30pm, moving to the upper section of the cemetery around 3pm.
