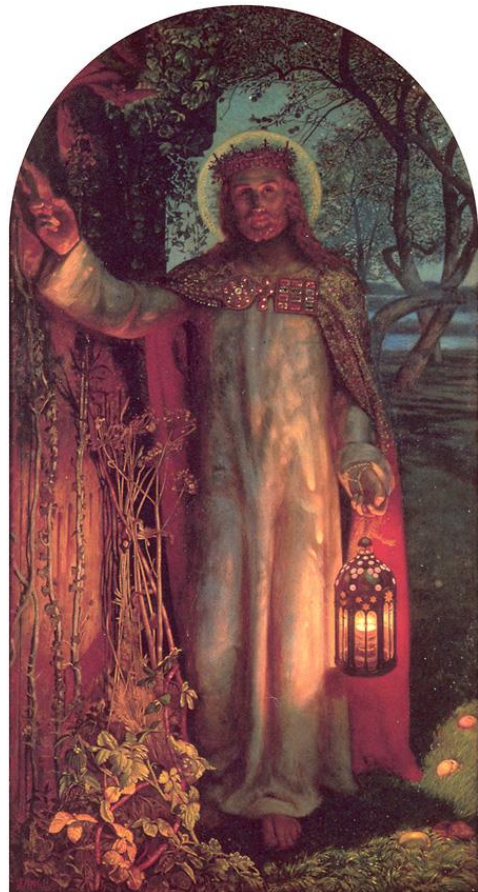

#### Our Lady of Fatima

On Saturday 18th February Westminster Cathedral will be visited by the National Pilgrim Statue of Our Lady of Fatima along with the relics of Blessed Jacinta and Francisco for the Fatima centenary. During mass Cardinal Nichols will be receiving and crowning the statue and will consecrate England to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The statute and relics will arrive at 13.45 on Saturday and remain in the Cathedral until 14.30 the following day. After Mass people will be invited to venerate the relics and participate in Marian devotions. This will be followed by a Fatima Symposium in Westminster Cathedral Hall.
