Salvatorian Province Chapter 2018

During the last week the Provincial Superior (Father Richard) and his Council met together with elected representatives from around the GB Province to prepare for the General Chapter of the Salvatorian Order, which takes place in Germany this coming August. Father Richard and Father Paul will represent the GB Province at this meeting, during which a new Superior General and Council will be elected to serve the Order for the next 6 years.

Aside from our preparatory discussions for the General Chapter, we very much considered our local presence here in the UK. Whilst we are now small in number, we remain dedicated to our present ministries, both here in the Westminster Diocese, and further afield. We also remembered all those who are dedicated to our care in the parishes in which we minister. I would ask all parishioners to remember us in our work, most especially praying that God will call more men to serve as Salvatorian priests here in the UK.

An important aside...many parishioners have made enquiries about Father John Murray - one time curate and resident retired member here for a number of years. Father John remains in hospital and is now close to death. Please keep him in your prayers as he journeys home to the Father.

We have a number of funerals in the parish at present and I offer my sincere condolences to all families affected by bereavement - may you experience the closeness of God at this time of sadness.

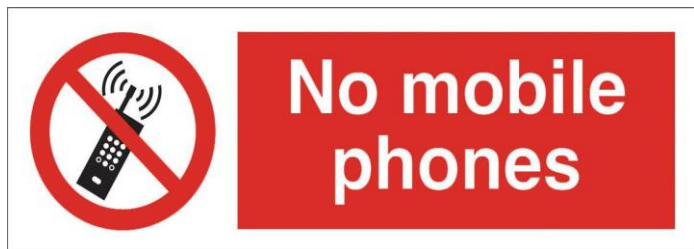
