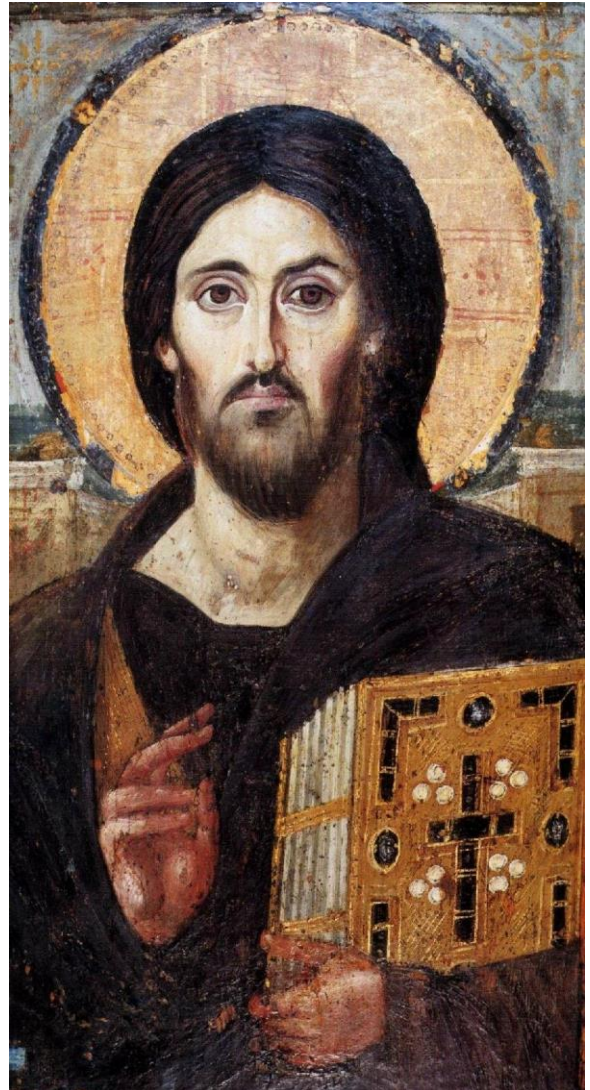

Examination success at Salvatorian & Sacred Heart
Congratulations to our local high schools who have done very well in their recent GCSE exams. The percentage of Salvo boys obtaining a grade 4 or above in English and maths has risen to 77%. Likewise highlights from the Sacred Heart School include 86% achieving a pass grade in English and maths; 84% gaining 5 or more GCSE grades - including a pass in English and maths; 65% achieving the English Bacalaureate.
