### Month of the Rosary

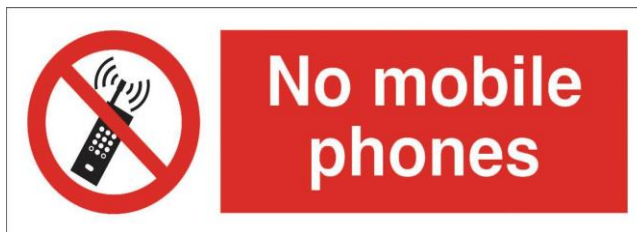
