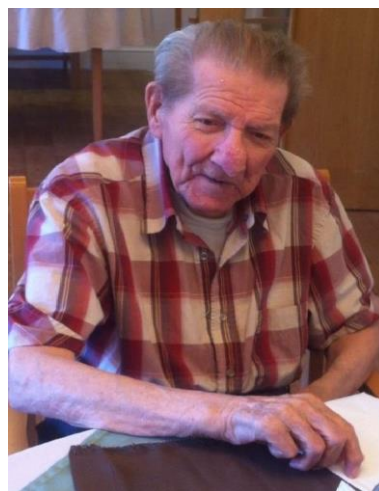

Dear Parishioners,



I'm sad to inform people that Father Charles Reddan died peacefully in his sleep on Thursday night. He had received the last sacraments and members of his family were with him when he passed. In accordance with his wishes, Father Charles' funeral will be held here in St Joseph's, followed by interment in the Salvatorian plot in Harrow Weald Cemetery. Funeral details to follow.

Father Charles served the church faithfully as a priest and a Salvatorian in many different ways, spending time in Tanzania as a missionary priest, working in the UK conducting mission appeals and also serving in parish ministry. Many here, young and old, will remember Charles for his love and kindness and for his approachable nature, not to mention his generosity, his Irish dancing and his skills on the button accordion. He loved his ministry, especially here in Harrow and we are honoured to hold his funeral in our parish. May God be good to him and reward him for his faithful service to the Church.

I'm very sorry to have to inform the parish that the annual Christmas Lunch will not be able to go ahead this year. This, as you will understand, is owing to the fact that the college is not functioning at present and much of the kitchen equipment has been re-located to the Priestmead site to cope with the extra pupils now working from there. I am confident that the Christmas Lunch will resume next year in the new school building. I appreciate many parishioners see the lunch as their offering to the marginalised and vulnerable. As such, we will hold a special Christmas appeal to enable those who wish to support the needy. Details to follow soon.
