"We will remember them..."

Once again, the nation falls silent this Sunday to remember those who have died in the two world wars, as well as those service personnel who lost their lives in more recent conflicts. As such, we welcome the uniformed organisations to our 11am Solemn Mass this Sunday as part of their act of remembrance. I will be representing the Roman Catholics at the Civic Service taking place at the cenotaph outside the council buildings in Harrow. Please remember that we also have the annual blessing of graves at Clamp Hill on Sunday at 2pm, meeting first at the main cemetery gates.

On behalf of the Salvatorian Fathers, I would like to extend our thanks to all parishioners who came along to the funeral rites of Father Charles Reddan. Both masses were well attended and the family commented on how well the parish turned out for Charles. Thank you also for the donations in memory of Charles, which amounted to £570 for the Salvatorian Missions.

As you know, we are not in a position to host our annual Christmas lunch this year. I appreciate that many parishioners see this event as part of their giving to the most vulnerable at Christmas. As such, I have given much thought to what we might do as a parish to continue to support those in need. Every year, 200,000 children suffer the distress and heartache of losing a dad, mum, brother or sister due to imprisonment. These children often live in poor households, with a parent or carer who is often forced to relocate, and who themselves may be struggling to cope. Many of these children are dealing with shame, embarrassment, stigma and loneliness. Prison Advice and Care Trust along with Caritas Westminster are working together to ensure that these kids get the best possible Christmas and I would like very much for us at St Joseph's to help on this occasion. More information to follow but, in brief, parishioners would be given the name of a child to pray for and to provide a Christmas gift, which would be taken into prison and given to a prisoner to hand over to their child on a special gift day.
