Operation Christmas Elf 2018

Every year, 200,000 children suffer the distress and heartache of losing a dad, mum, brother or sister due to imprisonment. These children often live in poor households, with a parent or carer who is often forced to relocate, and who themselves may be struggling to cope. Many of these children are dealing with shame, embarrassment, stigma and loneliness. Prison Advice and Care Trust along with Caritas Westminster are working together to ensure that these kids get the best possible Christmas and I would like very much for us at St Joseph's to help on this occasion.

Parishioners are invited to sign up to providing a Christmas gift for a child/teenager in the side chapel of St Joseph. There you will find information and guidance about what to buy and what not to do. You will find 7 different age groups you may provide a gift for and you are free to sign up for one or more gifts. A suggested guideline price for the purchase of a gift is £10. As we want the children to feel special and cared for, it is asked that second-hand, used gifts are not donated.

Donated gifts should not be wrapped as they will need to go through the usual security checks once they arrive at the prison. Your gifts will be wrapped by volunteers of the Prison Advisory and Care Trust inside the prison. To this end, sharp items, electronic toys, replica weapons, play dough or any toys that make ticking sounds should be avoided.

Your Christmas gifts should be brought along to Church on the first Sunday of Advent - 2nd December - and left in the Catechists office/Guild Room. As space is very limited, please don't bring gifts any earlier, unless by prior arrangement with the parish office.

As it's impossible to host our Christmas Lunch this year, I trust parishioners will agree with me that this is a worthy alternative to support.
