13-06-1936 - 13-01-2018

Father John passed away last Saturday morning, peacefully in his sleep at Charing Cross Hospital, Hammersmith, after a short illness. His niece, Anne was with him until the end, and he received much care and attention from both the medical staff and our House Manager, Lucella McCarthy. Father John had spent the last three years living in care at Nazareth House, Hammersmith, where he was happy and felt very much at home.

During his life, Father John served mainly in parish-based ministry, and the majority of that ministry was exercised here in Wealdstone over three different periods of time. He had a warm and approachable nature and his kindness and good-humour characterised his priesthood, making him a favourite among the young and older parishioners alike.

A welcome is extended to all parishioners to attend Father John's funeral. As Wealdstone parish was very close to Father John's heart, it's right and fitting that we celebrate his life and ministry here and give thanks to God for his faithful service as a Salvatorian priest and religious.
