These candles are 100% smoke free so as to avoid blackening of the surrounding paintwork. Many people have already made positive comments about how much better it is to have real candles back in the church, but unlike electric candles, real candles actually cost money so we cannot afford for candles to be lit without making the suggested donation of 50p. The cost of keeping the church open 12 hours a day, together with utility bills, continues to rise. Candle offerings make up a huge chunk of the annual income, which helps offset running costs. Please bear this in mind when making your candle offering.
