The Season of Advent

There is a marked change of gear in the Church as we begin a new liturgical year.

This Sunday we switch to purple vestments, we omit the Gloria and the liturgy seems a good bit more sober. These changes remind us that we are now in the Holy Season of Advent, the time when we start to ready ourselves spiritually for the celebration of Christmas.

There are some new things too such as Advent Candles and different hymns. The scripture readings now concentrate on John the Baptist and on the need for repentance. Maybe at home you might put up a Jesse Tree or an Advent Calendar to help the children prepare well for Christmas.

Advent is a uniquely Christian way of preparing for Christmas. It is completely out of sync with the commercial run up to Christmas which focusses mostly on shopping and parties.

Advent is a time if not of actual fasting then at least of sobriety and thoughtfulness. It is a time to repent of our sins so that we are ready to celebrate the Nativity of Christ properly through an increase in our own personal holiness and devotion.

So let us mark the season of Advent in a truly Christian way. Let us use this season as a time for repentance and spiritual preparation so that when it comes around Christmas will be all the better for its sudden arrival.
