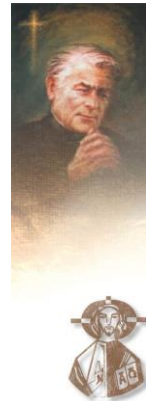

Mass Cards

Mass cards should be purchased from the repository, donations for Mass cards should not be placed in the small white envelopes, but instead you can pay for the card when you make your purchase from the repository.

Church Cleaning

We are very grateful and would like to thank those who have volunteered to help the current team with washing the altar linen, a very important but rewarding task. We are now looking for help with the cleaning of the church. Currently we have one team of cleaners and they do a fabulous job of keeping the church clean every week but they could do with some help. The main tasks involved are sweeping the floor of the church and altar, cleaning and polishing the brass handles and finger plates on the main doors into the church and sacristy and polishing/dusting the benches. Ideally we would like to set up four teams so that each team would do this important task once a month. So what we are asking is that you spare approximately an hour or so once a month.
