Extraordinary Month of Mission

As Christians, we believe that we are called to join in God's mission – whether that means going overseas or over the road – and we work to set people free to put this call into action.

Here in the British Province of our Order we have a particularly strong link with our overseas missions. Many of our older and deceased members served in the Tanzanian Mission and one was instrumental in re-establishing our Indian Mission. Today we have six members from Africa working with us; three from Congo and three from Tanzania.

In recent years our Order has been placing an increasing emphasis on the missions and we have got ourselves established in quite a few new countries such as Albania, Belarus, Cameroon, China, Comoros, Ecuador, Guatemala, Hungary, Kenya, Madagascar, Mozambique, Mexico, Philippines, Russia, Scotland, Slovakia, Sri Lanka, Ukraine and Vietnam. You can see from this that the expansion of our Order has been very rapid in recent years.

In all of these countries we are accepting new vocations and this means that we have to find the necessary personnel and construct suitable buildings so that our new recruits can be properly trained.

First Holy Communion 2020



Forms to register your child for First Holy Communion in May 2020 can be collected from today after the 9.30am Family Mass or from the Parish Office. To register your child (who must be in Year 3 or above) you will need to return the form, together with a copy of your

Child's Baptism Certificate (if they were not baptised at St Joseph's) and £20 to cover the costs of books and stationery. Forms can be collected until 27th October and **MUST** be returned by **Sunday 3rd November**. Classes will begin in January 2020. Children who are attending non Catholic Schools must attend the Children's Liturgy on Sunday mornings at 9.30am once registered.

Canonisation of John Henry Cardinal Newman

In two weeks' time, Blessed John Henry Newman will be declared a saint of the Church. He lived in Ealing and is, therefore, a native of our Diocese. His care for those facing poverty must be a hallmark of our lives too. It is a most effective way of witnessing to our faith.

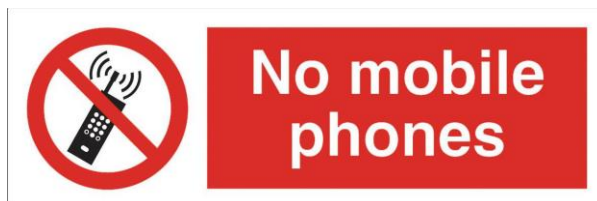
