## October 2019: Extraordinary Month of Mission

To commemorate the 100th anniversary of Pope Benedict XV's Apostolic Letter *Maximum Illud*, Pope Francis has declared October 2019 to be an Extraordinary Month of Mission (EMM). This special month of prayer and action calls us all to renew our missionary commitment. We are called to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with all peoples.

For the 4 weeks of October 2019, there are 4 themes:

*First week: A personal encounter with Jesus Christ living in his Church: As we participate in the sacraments (Eucharist, Reconciliation, ...) we receive the necessary grace to be a living part of the Church, and witnesses of what we believe.*

*Second week: The witness of missionary saints and martyrs: Through the ages of the Church, women and men, like Christ, have offered their lives for their faith in God. The Lord himself told the first disciples that they would be hated, misunderstood, persecuted, tried and possibly be put to death, for our faith in God through him. Suffering and some form of sacrifice are the aspects of the life of a disciple.*

*Third week: Missionary charity as a commitment to support the Church's missionary activities: we are invited to put our faith in Him into action in our lives. Our faith must find expression in practical ways each day. **That is why we are going to have a second collection for World Mission Sunday 20th October.***

Fourth week: Formation for Mission: We are baptised to be sent. To discover and renew our understanding of being sent. The Catholic Church is essentially missionary.

## First Holy Communion 2020



Forms to register your child for First Holy Communion in May 2020 can be collected from today after the 9.30am Family Mass or from the Parish Office. To register your child (who must be in Year 3 or above) you will need to return the form, together with a copy of your

Child's Baptism Certificate (if they were not baptised at St Joseph's) and £20 to cover the costs of books and stationery. Forms can be collected until 27th October and **MUST** be returned by **Sunday 3rd November**. Classes will begin in January 2020. Children who are attending non Catholic Schools must attend the Children's Liturgy on Sunday mornings at 9.30am once registered.

### Canonisation of John Henry Cardinal Newman

The London Oratory will celebrate the canonisation of John Henry Newman at the London Oratory with the following Masses: Sunday 13th October at 11.00am will be a Solemn Mass of Thanksgiving for the canonisation of Bl John Henry Newman with *Te Deum*. Thursday 17th October at 6.30pm there will be Solemn Pontifical Mass in honour of our new saint, celebrated by our Cardinal Archbishop. All are most welcome to attend. See notice board for details.
