First Holy Communion 2020



Forms to register your child for First Holy Communion in May 2020 can be collected from today after the 9.30am Family Mass or from the Parish Office. To register your child (who must be in Year 3 or above) you will need to return the form, together with a copy of your Child's Baptism

Certificate (if they were not baptised at St Joseph's) and £20 to cover the costs of books and stationery. Forms can be collected until 27th October and **MUST** be returned by **Sunday 3rd November**. Classes will begin in January 2020. Children who are attending non Catholic Schools must attend the Children's Liturgy on Sunday mornings at 9.30am once registered.
