### Experiencing a Vocation

When we think about the calling of the first disciples our thoughts automatically turn to the question of vocations in the Church today. We see the call to be an Apostle and the call to be a priest or religious in the Church of today as being essentially the same.

The Apostles responded to the call of Jesus in an immediate and radical way. Not one of them asked for time to consider what Jesus was calling them to do and each of them responded wholeheartedly to him even though they knew this was going to mean them leaving behind family and loved ones.

Those who experience the call of God in the world of today should take great heart from the response of the first disciples. No one is saying that choosing to follow the Lord as a priest, brother or sister is an easy one. It is difficult but, without a doubt, it is a very rewarding life.

What we would urge anyone who thinks that they may be experiencing such a call is to talk about it with a priest or a religious. If you experience something that sounds like it might be a vocation then you will need to talk to someone who has had the same experience that you are going through and who can give you the advice you need.

No one who responds to God's call will ever be disadvantaged if they decide to follow him. And giving time to discern one's call in a religious institute or a seminary will certainly be rewarded.

Please be assured of the prayerful support of the whole parish if you are experiencing the call of God.

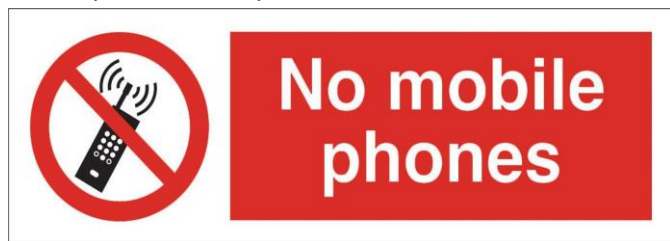
