This coming Wednesday marks the beginning of the holy season of Lent - 40 days of fasting, abstinence and almsgiving. We will have three opportunities for mass on this day, whilst the pupils of Salvatorian College, Sacred Heart, and St Joseph's will have their own masses and liturgies in school.

Keeping a good Lent doesn't finish with church-based activities. The usual practices of fasting, self-denial, and almsgiving should be at the heart of our endeavours without question, but Lent is also about coming to a much deeper awareness of the love and mercy of God. Thus, a deepening of prayer, together with a thorough examination of one's conscience before making a sacramental confession is essential for all of us. You will also find some light spiritual reading for Lent at the back of the church which is available at a small cost.

I also strongly appeal to all parishioners for a greater effort in avoiding unnecessary/noisy chatter in the church before mass, especially as we enter this holy season - speak to God before mass and to each other after mass!
