Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we move into the season of Passiontide - it is a season within a season. During this time the church focuses more earnestly upon the Passion and death of our Blessed Lord and so accompany him on his journey to Calvary. As such, our liturgies in church become more sombre and sorrowful. One obvious example of this is the veiling of the statues and crosses in the church. This practice helps us to get into the right frame of mind for the Sacred Triduum - the holiest three days in the life of the Church.

At the back of the church you will find a short guide to the liturgies of the Sacred Triduum. I hope this will help us all understand more fully as to what the Sacred Triduum is about, and why it is so important to all Christians. I commend this little bit of reading to all parishioners and ask that careful consideration be given to your attendance at these celebrations.

Over the page, you will see a list of all the liturgical celebrations over Holy Week. Please make sure to note the various times carefully so as not to miss out. As we journey together during this sacred time I gently remind parishioners to continue to maintain a sacred silence in the church, most especially before and after mass.

Finally, and on behalf of the Society for the Protection of Unborn Children, a very sincere thanks to all of you for responding so generously to the recent appeal. Almost £1900 was raised for this important work.

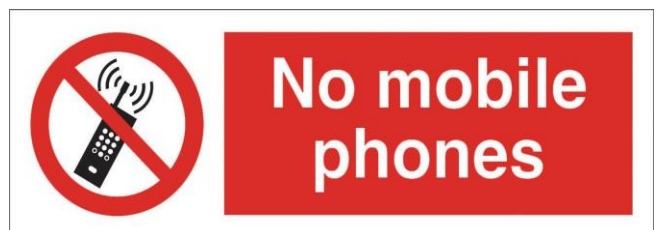
