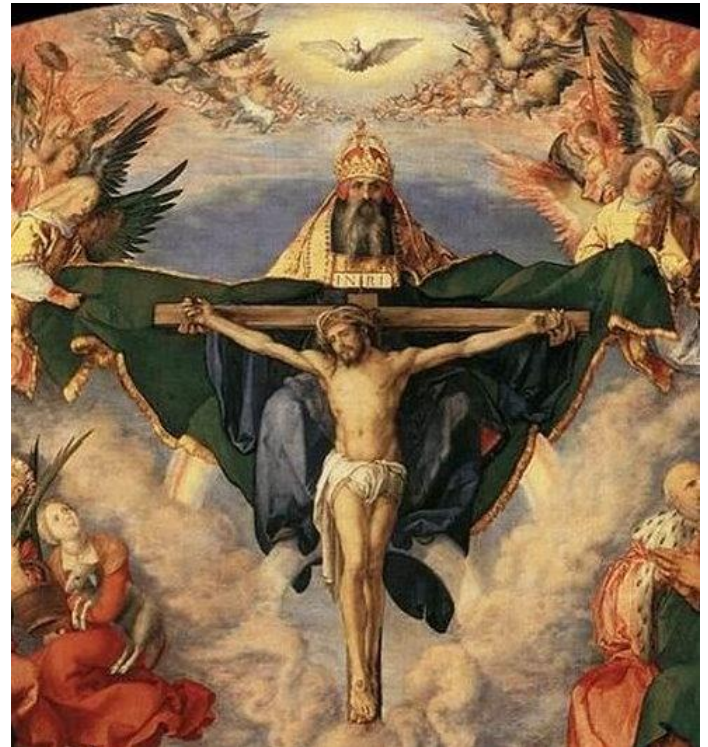

God, always, raises up founders of religious movements that continue the salvific work of Jesus. Father Jordan (16 June 1848 – 8 sept 1918) is one of them. He founded the Salvatorian fathers and brothers (1881) and the Salvatorian Sisters (1888). His work continues to flourish around the world. Father Jordan's vision of a movement of priests, Religious, and laity working together "so that all may know the One True God, and Jesus Christ whom He has sent" remains the guiding force of the Salvatorian community.

In the years the community has expanded to include Lay Salvatorians, who promise to follow the Salvatorian charism according to their state in life. The Salvatorians now exist on all continents. As the movement grows, so does the good work of the community, which includes schools, hospitals, missions, parishes, chaplaincies, and many others. In short, in the charism of Jordan, the Salvatorians use "all ways and means that the love of Christ inspires" to spread the love of the Divine Saviour to all people.

Parish Council Minutes

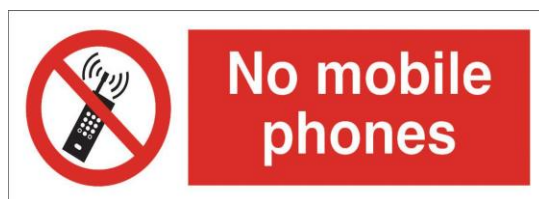
The minutes from our Parish Council Meeting in May are available to read on the noticeboard by St Joseph's Shrine.
