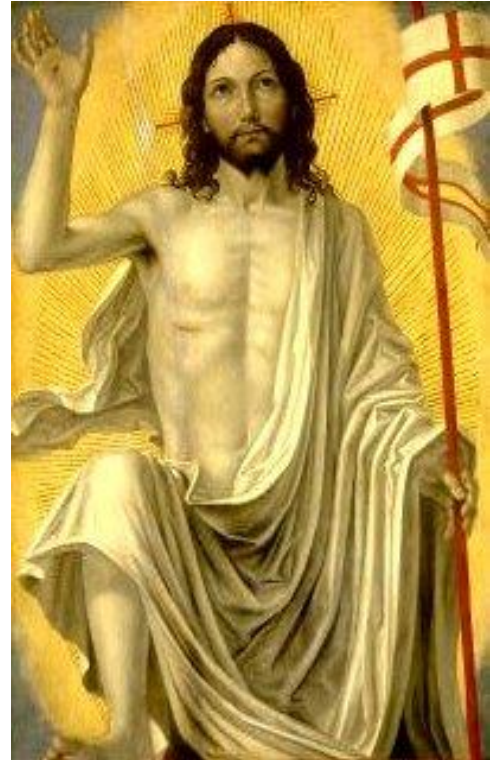

Sanctuary Lamp Intentions

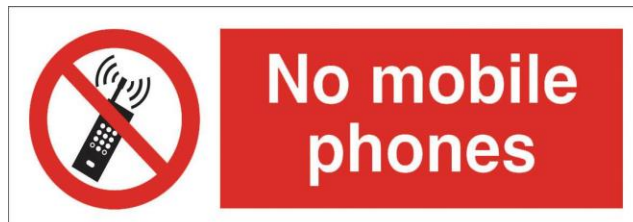
