### Sanctuary Lamp Intentions

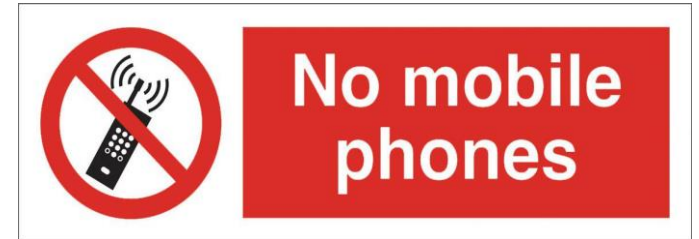
