He was recently diagnosed with cancer and chose to spend his last days in the community at Wealdstone before he passed away at St Luke's Hospice, Kenton. May he rest in peace.



**Father Liam Talbot SDS**

**3rd July 1937 – 5th February 2020**

Father Liam Talbot worked in Africa, Australia, and Runcorn, Cheshire. He then was appointed Parish Priest at Sallynoggin, Co Dublin, before moving to the Borough, London to work on the parish there. He eventually retired to Ireland. He was attending a routine hospital appointment when he was taken ill, collapsed and died. May he rest in peace.

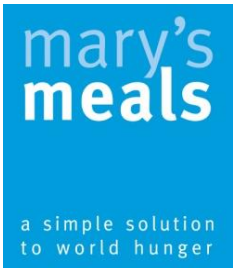
### Sanctuary Lamp Intentions
