

Dear Parishioners,

We are delighted to inform you that we are now permitted to open the church for individual prayer. However, we have a considerable number of guidelines and safety issues that we are required to follow. Two of these guidelines are that we need to have stewards present in the church whilst the church is open, and we also need cleaners to sanitise the church at the end of every period that the church is opened for.

We are very grateful to the team of cleaners who have volunteered to help us but what we need are stewards to be present in the church when open. Initially we are planning to open the church for individual prayer on Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 3pm to 6pm. In order to do this, we require at least 3 stewards to be present in the church during these times. Ideally, we would like to have a different team for each day.

With this in mind I would like appeal to you to step forward and volunteer to be a steward. Training and guidance would be given in advance. Please note that to be a steward you must be under 70 and have no health issues or be in isolation or shielding.

If we do not get stewards, then sadly we will not be able to open the church. If you are able to help, then please contact any member of the Parish team or by email (office@catholicwealdstone.org)

We are hoping to open on Monday June 22nd providing we have met with all the safety requirements. With my best wishes for you and your families.
