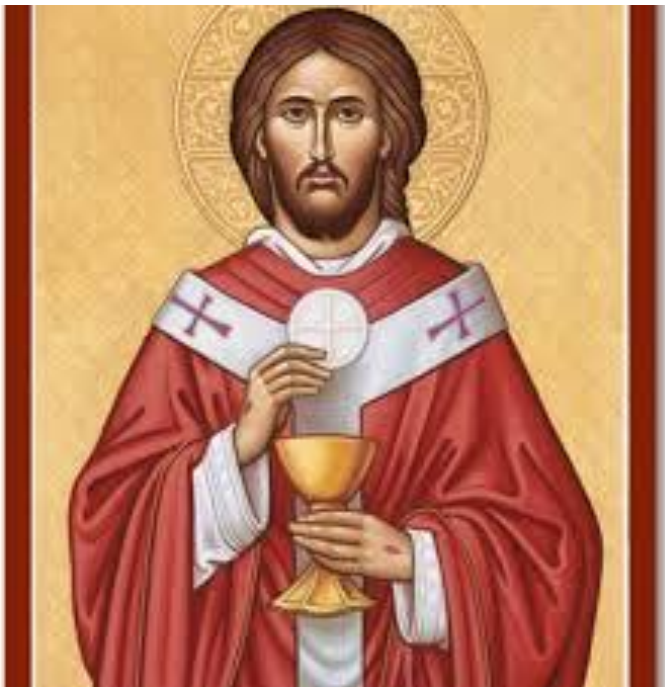

Covid-19 Route Map: Step 4 & Guidance

The following are recommendations from the Bishops of England & Wales:

- If you are not already vaccinated against the virus, you are encouraged to do so as soon as possible.
- Churches will continue to provide hand sanitisers at their entrances. Face coverings are strongly recommended while in Church.
- Churches should be places where people feel safe. Although social distancing has been removed from legislation, people are encouraged to be sensible.
- Stewards will continue to be in attendance to provide a welcoming presence at the Church door and organise an orderly queue for Holy Communion.

These arrangements are now in force.

9.30am Mass will resume from **Sunday 19th September**. On that same day, 12.45pm Mass will return to its original time of 12.30pm. Confessions will be resumed from **Saturday 18th September** 10.30am – 11.00am with Adoration and Confessions from 5.30pm – 6.00pm (before the Vigil Mass).

The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary

On Wednesday 8th September the Cardinal will celebrate Mass at 11.00am in Thanksgiving for the Beatification of Father Francis Jordan. There will be no 10.00am Mass that day. All are most welcome to attend.

Sunday Obligation

The Bishops of England and Wales have indicated that the Sunday Obligation to attend Mass should return from 1st Sunday of Advent (28th November 2021).

Please remain kind and respectful of other parishioners, and as much as possible, leave a space between yourself and others, who are not part of your household/bubble.
