Nothing that goes into a man from outside can make him unclean

The Gospel today tells us about the complaint of the Pharisees and some scribes that the followers of Jesus were not observing the proper Jewish laws when they did not wash their hands before eating.

Jesus is so clear in his reply. He tells us that he did not come to destroy the Law and the Prophets, but to fulfil them. Jesus has no problem with the person who washes his hands and still serves the poor and the needy. The problem is with us who make sure to wash our hands but don't pay attention to the poor and the needy in our midst! If I go to Church regularly but don't care about the poor and the needy, my churchgoing has no value. I should both be going to Church and serving the poor and the needy.
