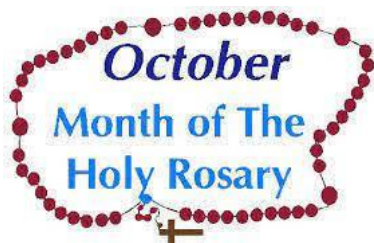
**XXVII Sunday Ordinary Time**

**3rd October 2021**



"But from the beginning of creation God made them male and female."

Jesus gives us a lot to think about in today's Gospel. He speaks especially on behalf of married women and of children. Both groups were vulnerable in Jesus' time and had little value or official protection. Women were too often seen as property, without social power to protect themselves from the whims of a husband's disloyalty or disinterest. Jesus re-iterates the unity of marriage. Husband and wife become one. They are no longer two but one body. Jesus gives us a glimpse or vision of God's loving plan. Jesus' words urge us to see the importance of marriage, rather than seeing commitment and love as fleeting.
