*Go and sell everything you own,... then come and follow me*

To know God is to love him above all else. To love him is to sacrifice everything we are and have for him. In sacrifice lies the true sense of worship, namely, spiritual worship. Material things, since they are created by God are good (Gen 1:31), possession of them is favour, but their possession of us is evil. It is, therefore, a crime against God to make a demon out of his beautiful gifts. Let us free our hearts of undue attachments. The great lesson is to beware of hidden idols in life. Until these idols are discovered and uprooted, our religious practices will only be superficial and unrewarding. Such idols can be in the guise of power, (as recorded in the first reading) riches and ego. They can also be in form of persons in our lives.

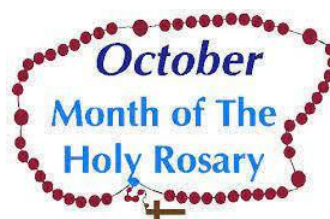
