In his Pastoral letter, Cardinal Vincent Nichols has given the worldwide project to prepare the Synod of Bishops in 2023. It involves a process of listening and sharing views of the life of the Church as we gradually move out of the pandemic. The questions to be considered are: ***During this terrible pandemic what strengths did I find in my faith and faith community? In what ways did the grace of God most clearly touch and uplift me? Who feels left out? What did we do better? How do we choose priorities over our own mission?***

These are the questions which we will be considering individually and together in the coming weeks. Please think about them and we can make suggestions as to how we think the church should move forward.

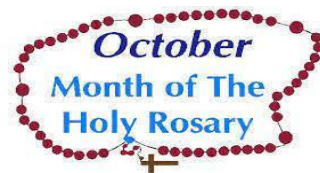
