## Salvatorian College GCSE Results

Congratulations to Year 11 students who have achieved a higher percentage of 9 to 7 (A\*-A) grades than ever before, with the majority progressing to St Dominic's Sixth Form College. This year, following cancellation of exams, grades were awarded by teachers against a national standard. The government is not publishing performance data for schools; however, internal estimates show a progress score of around +0.9, putting the school firmly in 'Outstanding' territory. We pray for the boys and their families as they progress to the next stage in their education.

Congratulations to our Year 11 Students who have triumphed in their summer exams, showing great courage and resilience throughout the last year. 57% of all grades were awarded at the higher levels of 7-9. 91% of our pupils achieved a pass in English and Maths.
