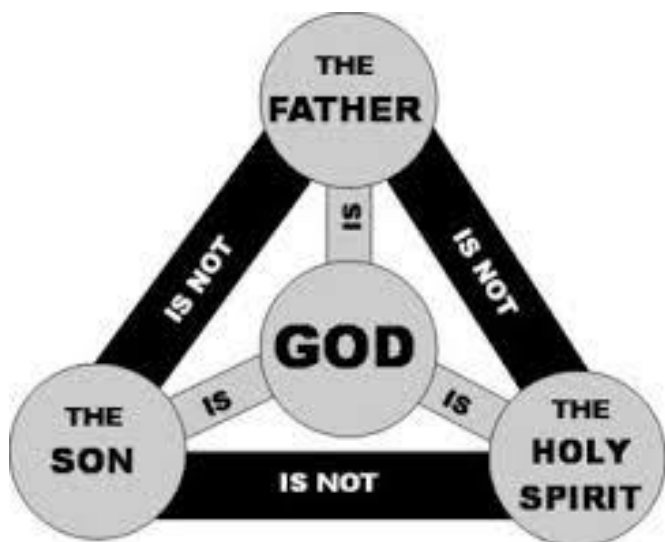

Pope urges Catholics to pray the Rosary for end to pandemic

Pope Francis has invited Catholics and Marian Shrines around the world to dedicate the month of May to a marathon of prayer for an end to the Covid-19 pandemic. We continue the global prayer marathon in the month of May, praying for the end of the pandemic. It is suggested that we say the Rosary each day for this intention either individually or perhaps joining by livestream the Rosary from one of the Marian shrines around the world. The Pope will also close the initiative on 31 May with another specially broadcast Rosary.
