**Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**2nd October 2022**



This Sunday's readings speak to us about Faith. The first reading and the Gospel underline the importance and power of faith in God, whereas in the second reading, Saint Paul exhorts us to be courageous in giving testimony of our faith in Jesus Christ.

Faith is a way of life, and therefore, it should not be relegated to the private sphere of one's life, nor be reduced to mere ideas or sentiments. Rather, we need to be courageous in living our faith coherently in every moment and circumstance of our daily life.
