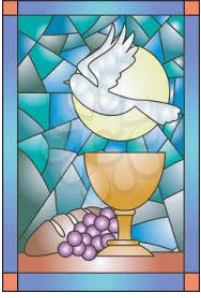
Family Fast Day Friday 6th October
