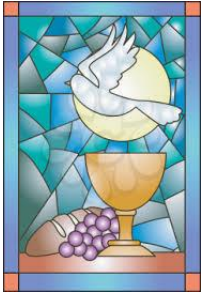

If your child was **NOT** baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of his/her baptism certificate.

The final day of registration for **Confirmation** will also take place **TODAY**, Sunday 15th October, after 9.30am Mass, **in the Salvatorian College**. Please bring your completed Registration form, signed photograph consent form & £40 registration fee. If you were not baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of your Baptism Certificate.
