Today's Gospel is about the Beatitudes. In the beatitudes, our Lord tells us what every one of us, deep down, wants to know: *how to be happy*. So, we must listen with great attentiveness. At the heart of the program is the beatitude: ***blessed are the merciful***. This is because mercy is a participation in the divine life itself. All the other beatitudes centre around and relate to this one.
