## The Most Holy Trinity

4th June 2023



*In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen*

The first Sunday after Pentecost we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, also known as Trinity Sunday. **The Trinity is “the central mystery of Christian faith and life and is the source of all the other mysteries of faith”** (CCC 234). The whole of the Church’s life flows from the central belief that the one true God exists as three divine Persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Today, we invite the Trinity to be more at home in our hearts in order to make them a more welcoming home for others—that through our smile, our gentleness, our availability of heart, everyone whom the Father entrusts to us may experience the Love that is their eternal home.
