Twenty-fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

15th September 2024



The Gospel reading for this Sunday explores Jesus' teaching on suffering. Jesus asks His disciples who they think He is, and Peter declares Him the Christ. When Jesus speaks about His coming suffering, Peter rebukes Him, but Jesus responds with, "Get behind me, Satan!" He explains that following Him means denying oneself and taking up the cross.

This passage teaches that while we naturally want to avoid pain, following Jesus often involves enduring suffering for a greater purpose.
