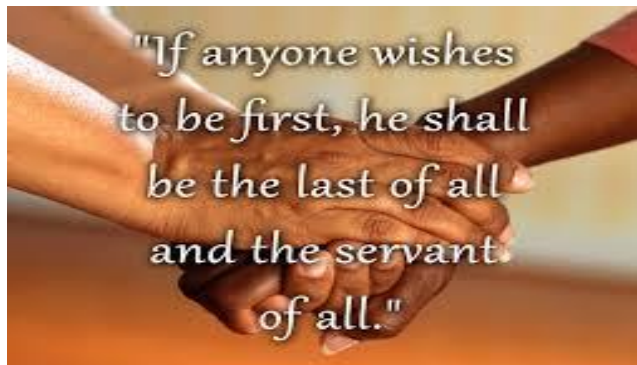

This Sunday's Gospel tells of the apostles arguing about who is the greatest. Jesus teaches them that true greatness comes from being humble and serving others. He uses a child to illustrate that we must welcome and care for those who are seen as least important. This passage shows that comparing ourselves to others leads to jealousy and ambition. Instead, we should appreciate our own unique gifts and use them to serve God and others. Humility helps us value ourselves and others without competition.

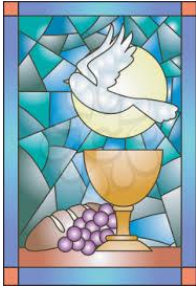

Registration for **First Holy Communion** will take place on Sunday 13th & Sunday 20th October, after 9.30am Mass, **in the Parish Hall**. Please bring your completed Registration form, signed photograph consent form and £30 registration fee. If your child was **NOT** baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of his/her baptism certificate.

Registration for **Confirmation** will take place on Sunday 6th & Sunday 13th October, after the 9.30am, 11am and 12.30pm Masses, **in the Salvatorian College**. Please bring your completed Registration form, signed photograph consent form & £40 registration fee. If you were not baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of your Baptism Certificate.
