Today's readings teach us that we are free from the belief that we are the only ones representing God in this world. God is not just interested in labels: Catholic, Protestant, Muslim, Animist, Hindu, Buddhist etc. He is underlining the great truth that the essence of following Jesus is found in the way we live love. Very simple, but how very demanding. Love alone counts. A simple Taize chant puts it this way: "Where there is love, there is God." The basis of Jesus' ministry was hospitality and welcome.

The real challenge is whether we accept that the Spirit of God today works wherever God wishes and through whomsoever is chosen. We simply must be open to the Spirit's working in our world.

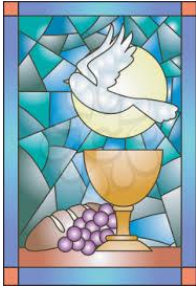
