Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for this Sunday encourage us to seek God's wisdom and prioritize our spiritual journey. By following Jesus and trusting in God's power, we can overcome the challenges of earthly attachments and strive for eternal life.

The first reading tells us that wisdom is more valuable than power, wealth, and even health; true wisdom comes from God and is more precious than anything we can possess. In the Gospel, Jesus' call to the rich young man is a reminder for all of us to follow Him without reservation. It emphasizes the importance of prioritizing our relationship with Jesus over anything else. This reassures us that God can help us overcome any obstacles in our spiritual journey.

Next Sunday is World Mission Sunday

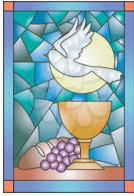

If your child was **NOT** baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of his/her baptism certificate.

Registration for **Confirmation** will take place **today** Sunday 13th October, after the 9.30am, 11am and 12.30pm Masses, **in the Parish Office**. Please bring your completed Registration form, signed photograph consent form & £40 registration fee. If you were not baptised at St Joseph's, you will need to bring a copy of your Baptism Certificate.
