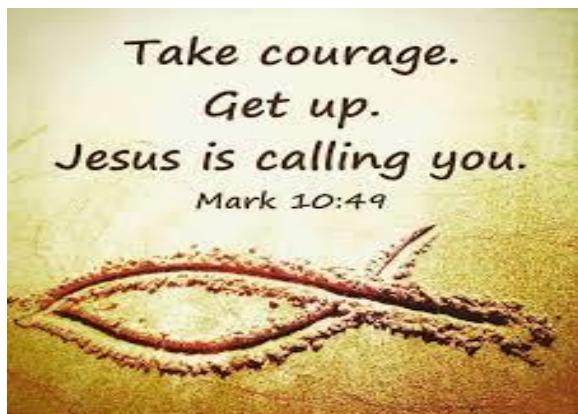

**Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**27<sup>th</sup> October 2024**



The readings of this Sunday show how God listens to our cries and heals our brokenness. Our God is love and mercy.

This Sunday's Gospel explores Bartimaeus' story. Bartimaeus, a blind beggar, calls out to Jesus and is healed because of his faith. He leaves his old life and follows Jesus.

We, like Bartimaeus, can suffer from spiritual blindness. We must have the courage to call out to Jesus and let Him guide us. By doing so, we can see clearly and follow His path.
