This Sunday the church invites us to recognize Jesus and grant him authority in our lives. The Gospel vividly demonstrates Jesus' divine authority, not just in teaching but also in his power over unclean spirits. His authority impresses and amazes the people, revealing him as a figure of divine power and wisdom. The reaction of the congregation to Jesus' exorcism teaching underlines the theme and recognizing and responding to Christ's power and authority. This response of amazement and the spread of Jesus' fame throughout Galilee are central to understanding the impact of Jesus' ministry in the lives of his disciples.
