Fifth Sunday Ordinary Time



The readings for this Sunday invite us to reflect on Jesus' power to heal us, both physically and spiritually. In the first reading, Job laments that he is experiencing so much misery and despair. But the psalm reminds us to "Praise the Lord, who heals the broken-hearted." The Gospel tells how Jesus cured Peter's mother-in-law, freed those possessed by demons. The Gospel emphasizes God's compassion and healing power. This theme underscores the Christian belief in a God who cares deeply about human affliction and actively works to restore and heal. It showcases Jesus' authority over illness and evil forces. This is the transformative power present in Jesus' ministry which marks the inauguration of a new era of divine action in the world.
