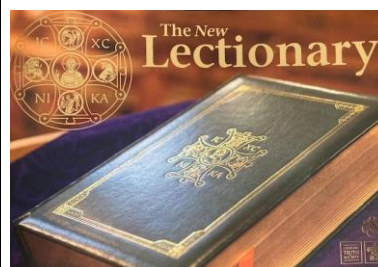

changes are intended to make the biblical translations more faithful to the original languages. If you currently use your own copy of the Sunday or Weekday Missal with lectionary, this will, unfortunately, go out of use from the 1st Sunday of Advent. The Lectionary comprises 4 volumes which cost £695 in total.
