... and I lay down my life for my sheep.

We continue our journey through Eastertide, experiencing the joy of the Risen Lord. This 4th Sunday of Easter traditionally features Jesus as the Good Shepherd, and is also kept annually as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations.

In the **Gospel**, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd, who is prepared to lay down his life for us; he knows us intimately and wants to bring everyone into his folk.

On this Day of Prayer for Vocations, we might pray that everyone should be willing and able to fulfil their own vocation.

We are invited to reflect on how faith in Jesus as the Good Shepherd and cornerstone helps us understand our identity as God's children and our mission in the world.

Pope's Intention for April


We pray that the dignity and immense value of women be recognized in every culture, and for the end of discrimination that they experience in different parts of the world.
