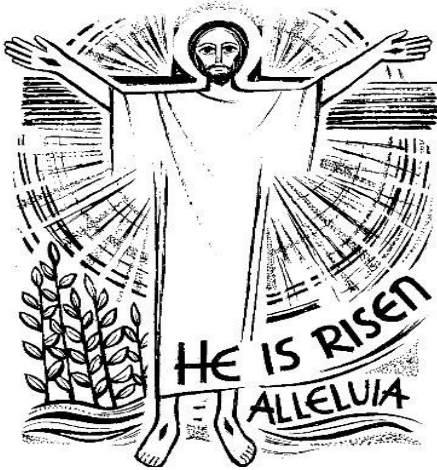

Third Sunday of Easter

14th April 2024



Today's gospel from St Luke is a bit unusual in some ways. Twice Jesus says to the disciples "Look at my hands and feet", rather than "Look at my face or listen to my voice". Could you recognise a member of your family by knowing a feature of their hands and feet? A freckled hand maybe or an ingrown toenail? But Jesus' hands must have been familiar to them from the time he blessed bread which was distributed to the 5000 or when he took a dead girl by the hand and raised her up. But now, of course, his hands were wounded with ugly holes and dark bruises. Likewise, we might ask, what do our hands and feet say about us? Where have they been? Whose lives have they touched? How have they served the gospel? At each Mass, we also draw close to the Lord – in hearing the scriptures, in the Eucharist and in each other. May we continue to recognise him in hands and feet that witness his message.
