

Fifth Sunday of Easter

28th April 2024



... whoever remains in me... bears fruit in plenty.

The 5th Sunday of Easter reminds us of our dependence on God and each other. In the gospel Jesus explains that he is the vine, and we must depend on him. Saint John uses the metaphor of the vine and the branches to illustrate the vital connection believers must maintain with Jesus. Just as branches can bear fruit only when attached to the vine, Christians can thrive spiritually only when they remain in Jesus.

We are called to bear fruit as evidence of our discipleship and our connection to Jesus. This fruitfulness also involves pruning, or spiritual discipline, to foster even greater growth.


