

Second Sunday of Lent

25th February 2024



The readings for the 2nd Sunday of Lent make us think of God's revelation of Jesus Christ as his Beloved Son and also how God loves us. The Gospel from St Mark describes the Transfiguration of Jesus, revealing divine glory. This event foreshadows the Paschal Mystery—His

suffering, death, and Resurrection. It also affirms Jesus as the Beloved Son and the fulfilment of the Law and the Prophets, represented by Moses and Elijah. The readings collectively invite us to reflect on our journey of faith, anticipating the ultimate fulfilment of God's promises through the Resurrection of Jesus. They encourage a deep trust in God's plan, even amidst trials and sufferings.
